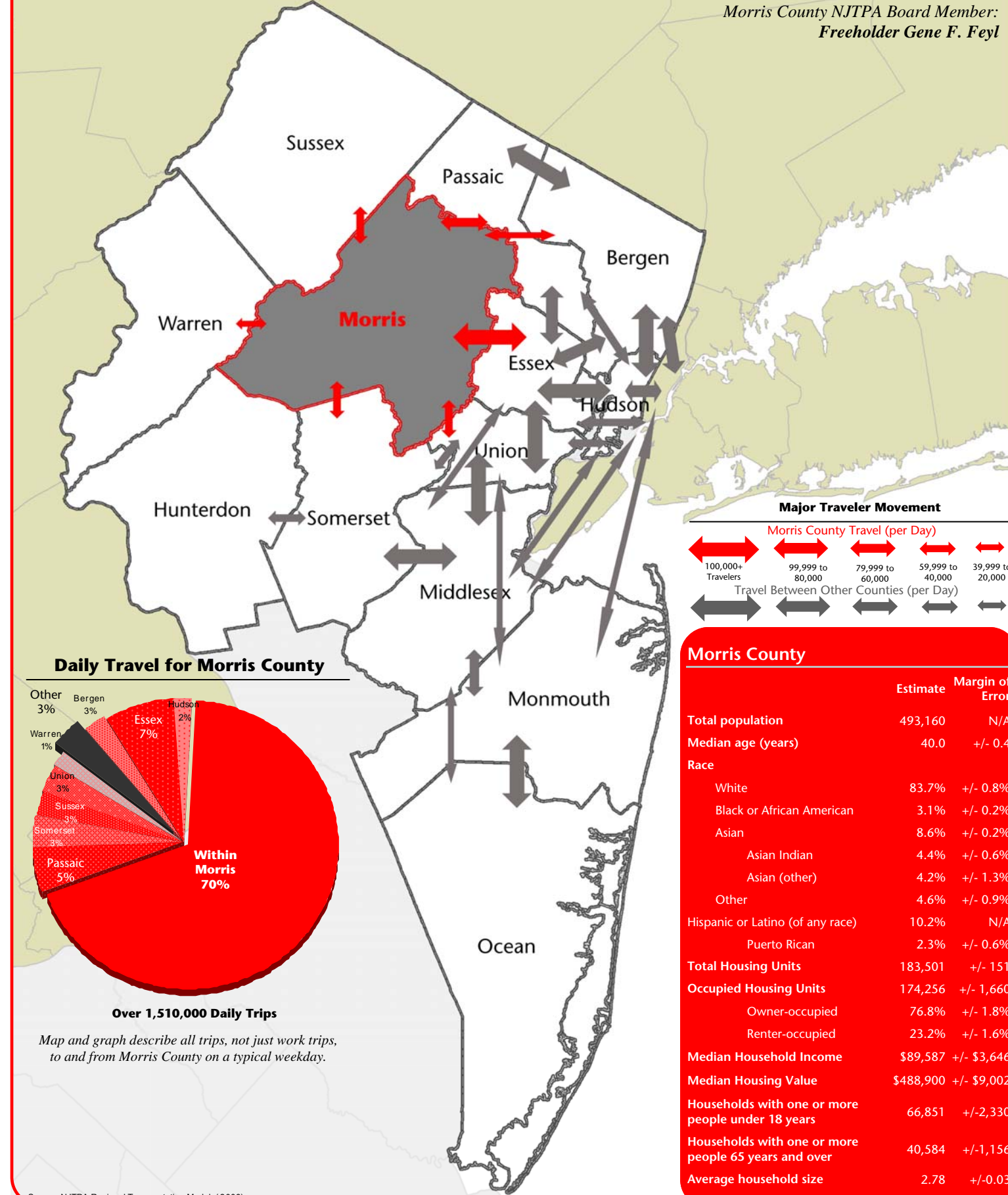
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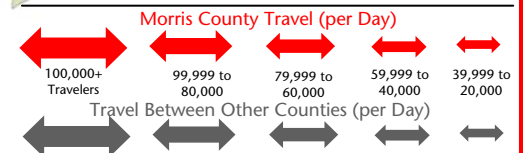

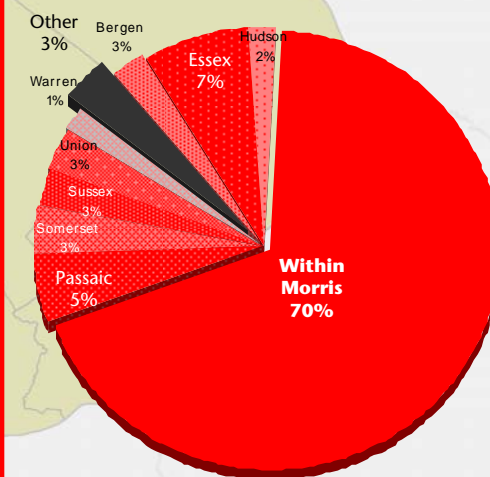

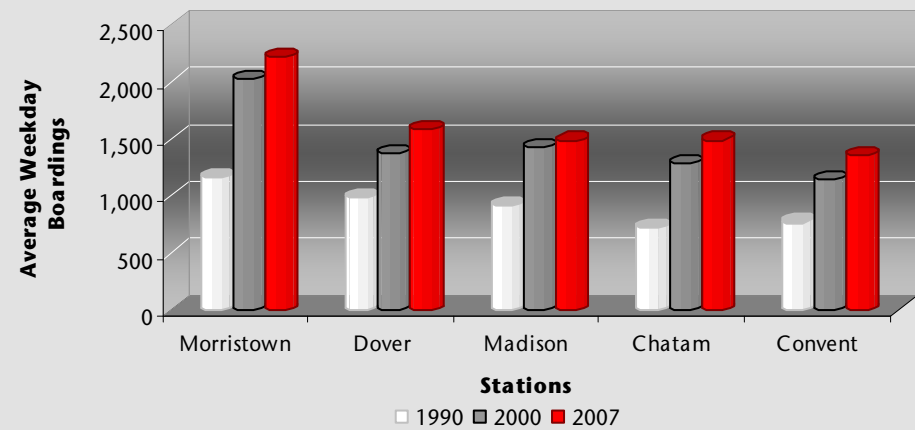

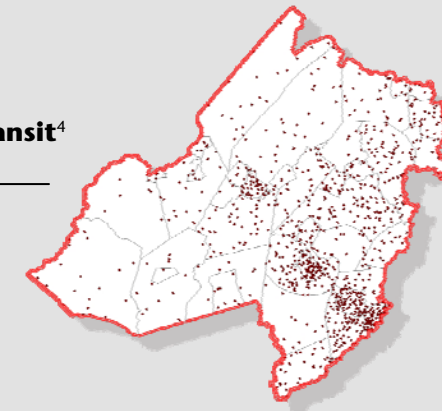

Rail Ridership by Stations in Morris County¹

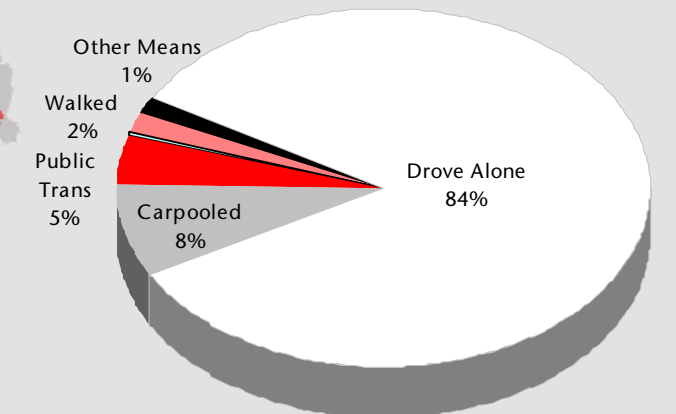


Residents Using Public Transit⁴ to Travel to Work

Means of Travel to Work for Morris Residents³

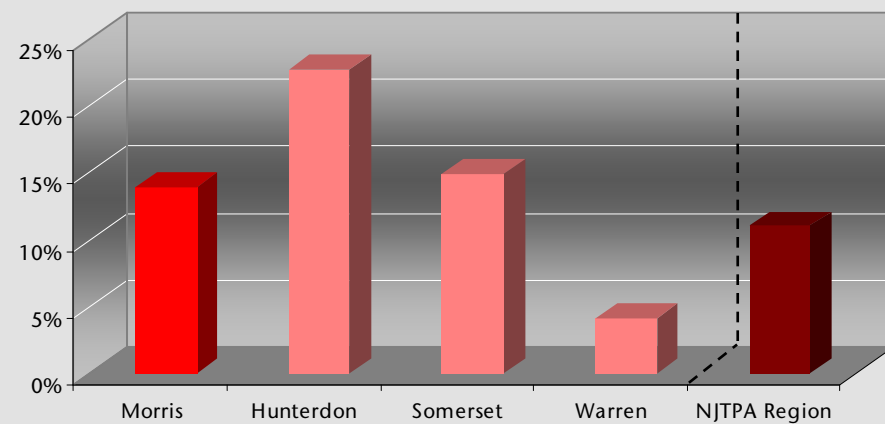


Automobile Travel

Statewide — 29.1 (+/- 0.2)

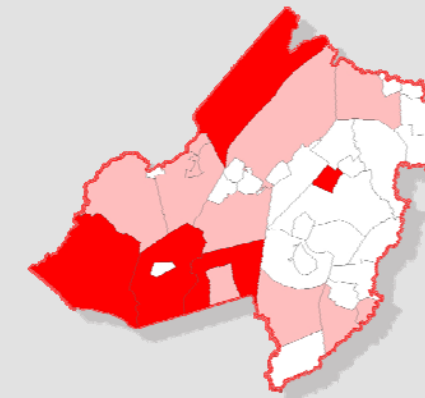

Change in Daily Vehicle Miles Traveled, 2000-2005²

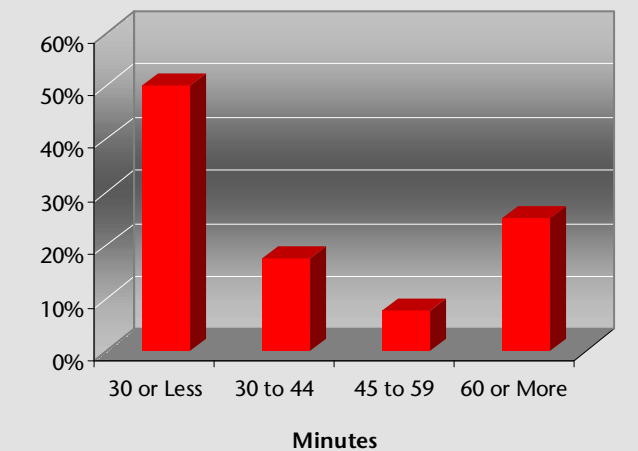


Resident Average⁴ Travel Time to Work

Travel Time to Work for Morris Residents³

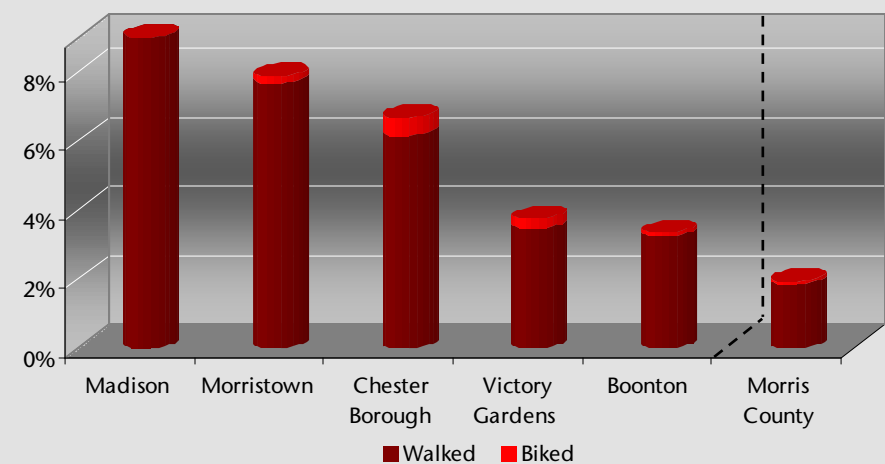


Walking and Biking

Statewide — 358,636 (+/- 9,258)

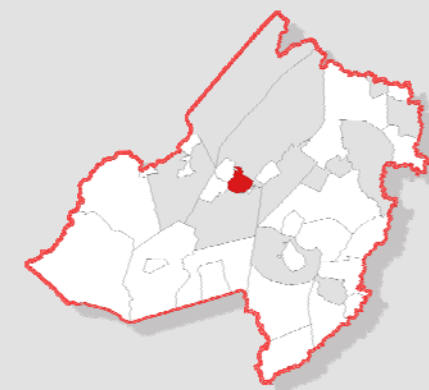
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Morris Residents Walking and Biking to Work, 2000⁴
