



The existing structure was built in 1972 as a temporary single-span structuure. The bridge consists of simply supported steel acrow panel trusses and is supported on concrete abutments. The bridge has inadequate deck geometry and substandard lane widths. The existing metal bridge deck components are overstressed (under-designed). This bridge is considered structurally deficient and functionally obsolete and hence is in need of replacement. The new structure will provide two 3.65 meter lanes, adequate shoulders on both sides, one sidewalk and will be constructed on an improved alignment.



The existing structure will be replaced on approximately the same footprint as the existing bridge. A temporary bridge will be installed on the west of the existing bridge to provide for detour traffic during construction. The new approach roadway will consist of two 12-foot lanes with six-foot shoulder on each side. The roadway will have a six-foot berm area with 2-to-1 side slopes to meet the existing conditions. A six-foot sidewalk will be constructed 150 feet north of the bridge and 350 feet south of the bridge. Some roadway reconstruction of School Road and Lower Hibernia Road is anticipated to meet Green Pond Road. The new bridge will be a 62-foot single-span steel girder section with a composite concrete deck, or a prestressed concrete box beam section.

Bridge over Whippany River

Improvements will include replacement of the existing Structure No. 1400790 and the widening of Structure No. 1400791 on the north side, realignment of the approach roadways in the immediate vicinity of the structures and resurfacing the existing roadway. This project includes improvements approximately 550 feet north of the center of the bridge. The road will be widened to two 12-foot lanes, two 6-foot shoulders, one 6-foot sidewalk on the eastern side and two parapet walls, 2 feet wide on either side, making a total roadway width of 46 feet. The Morris County Park Commission requested a sidewalk be included in this project to provide pedestrian access from the existing sidewalk at the Township of Morris Municipal Swimming Pool to Patriot's Path, approximately 800 feet north of the swimming pool as an enhancement to their park property.

This project provides for reconstruction, minor widening for shoulder improvements, minor realignment, drainage improvements and traffic signal improvements along Sussex Turnpike from Black River (Route 10) to just east of West Hanover Avenue, for a total length of approximately 4.3 miles. The project also includes the minor realignment of the intersection of West Hanover Avenue and Brookside Road as well as a widening from two to four lanes (with no shoulders) from Calais Road to West Hanover Road. When completed, Sussex Turnpike from Route 10 to Calais Road will be one 12-foot lane in each direction with 6-foot shoulders. Sussex Turnpike from Calais Road to just east of West Hanover Avenue will be one 11-foot lane and one 12-foot lane in each direction with no shoulders. There will be 12-foot dedicated left-turn lanes on eastbound Sussex Turnpike at Millbrook and West Hanover Avenues. There will also be a dedicated 12-foot left-turn lane on westbound Sussex Turnpike at Calais Road.

Construction will be multi-year funded under the provisions of Section 13 of P.L. 1995, c.108. The anticipated construction cost is \$25,200,000.
