Corridor improvements on Stagecoach Road in Millstone and Upper Freehold

Funding awarded: \$375,000

onmouth County received a \$375,000 grant for this project through the NJTPA's FY 2016-2017 High Risk Rural Roads Program (HRRRP). This project will improve motorist safety along a half-mile stretch of Stagecoach Road (CR 524) from Cherry Lane in Millstone to the intersection with Chambers Road and Roosevelt Road in Upper Freehold.

Project Details

Improvements will include: the application of a high friction surface treatment on the roadway; safety edging (which shapes the edge of the pavement to 30 degrees to minimize the vertical drop-off and allow drivers to safely reenter the paved road); signage to warn motorists about curves in the road; lighting at intersections; and safety striping.

About the Project Area

Stagecoach Road is a rural county road with numerous curves that runs through Millstone and Upper Freehold Township. There were two fatal crashes in June 2015 on the section of roadway being improved and 11 other crashes along that stretch of road between 2011-2014.

The HRRRP specializes in cost-effective, "quick-fix" solutions that can make an immediate impact on their target areas. The federally funded program was established by the NJTPA, in conjunction with the New Jersey Department of Transportation, to advance safety initiatives on county and local roads.
