

Intersection improvements at Cedar Bridge Avenue and Oberlin Avenue in Lakewood

Funding awarded: \$872,516

cean County received an \$872,516 grant for this project through the NJTPA's
FY 2016-2017 Local Safety Program (LSP).
This project will improve pedestrian safety, left turn movements and overall operations at the intersection of Cedar Bridge Road (CR 528) and Oberlin Avenue in Lakewood Township.

Project Details

Improvements will include: traffic signal upgrades and dedicated left turn lanes at all four approaches.

About the Project Area

There are five travel lanes on Cedar Bridge Road and two travel lanes on Oberlin Avenue. The intersection is located near the Lakewood Blue Claws FirstEnergy Park and Lakewood Township Airport. There are several private schools in the area, which has created an increase in school bus traffic. The intersection has the second highest crash rating in Ocean County.

The LSP is a federally funded program established by the NJTPA, in conjunction with the New Jersey Department of Transportation, to advance safety initiatives on county and local roads.
