Union County successfully applied for a \$396,000 grant for this project through the NJTPA's 2013 Local Safety Program. The project will replace antiquated traffic signal equipment and implement other safety improvements at three intersections on Vauxhall Road (CR 630) in Union Township.

Project Details

The project will target existing signalized intersections at Vauxhall Road and Caldwell Avenue, Glenn Avenue and Barbara Avenue/Pine Avenue. The improvements will include new traffic lights, signs, high visibility crosswalks, push button-activated pedestrian countdown signals, restriping and new pavement markings and the replacement of non-Americans with Disabilities Act compliant sidewalk ramps.

About the Project Area

This segment of Vauxhall Road is residential area located between interchanges with Interstate 78, the Garden State Parkway and U.S. Route 22. The intersections exhibited crash rates above state averages according to 2008-11 crash data.
