Chadwick Beach Island Bridge

**Funding awarded:
\$325,000**

Ocean County successfully applied for a \$325,000 grant for this project through the NJTPA's Fiscal Year 2018 Local Capital Project Delivery Program. This project will investigate options for replacing or rehabilitating the Chadwick Beach Island Bridge in Toms River Township.

Project Details

This project will study alternatives for replacing or rehabilitating the 13-span timber bridge. The bridge has two lanes and is 212 feet long. The timber bulkheads and load-bearing piles are deteriorating and need to be replaced. The bridge's width and sidewalk do not meet current standards.

About the Project Area

The bridge crosses the Barnegat Bay and serves as the only entry and exit point for residents of the more than 300 properties on

Chadwick Beach Island. It was originally built in the 1950s. In 1985, new deck boards, pile caps and railings were installed.

The Local Capital Project Delivery Program

The NJTPA's Local Capital Project Delivery Program awards grants to counties and cities to investigate all aspects of a project, including environmental, right of way access, design and feasibility issues. Projects that complete this initial investigative work, called the Local Concept Development Phase, may be eligible for eventual construction with federal funds.
