The City of Newark is hosting a public meeting for the **Newark Riverfront Pedestrian and Bicycle Access Concept Development (CD) Study**. The purpose of this CD Study is to identify safety and mobility improvements on Park Place / Center Street, from Broad Street to NJ 21, and on Broad Street from Rector Street to Washington Place, referred to as the Military Park Area, or NJ Performing Arts Center (NJPAC) Area. This project aims to:
