River Bridge

Bridge over Manasquan River, replacement

The Route 70 single-leaf bascule bridge over the Manasquan River was constructed in 1936 and is structurally deficient. The Department will construct a 40-foot, fixed-span bridge on the existing alignment. The existing bridge has two lanes in each direction, no shoulders, and a sidewalk on the westbound side. The new structure will have two lanes in each direction, 10-foot outside shoulders, 2-3 foot inside shoulders separated by concrete median barrier, with a sidewalk on the westbound side only. The cross section matches the Route 70 widening project adjacent to the bridge which is currently under construction. The new profile of the bridge impacts the intersection of River Road and Riveria Drive which is located at the westerly end of the structure. The new structure will continue over this intersection in the interest of safety. This will remove the existing signal and create a partial interchange at this intersection.




