This project will provide for the extension of a concrete island and restriping along Market Street to prevent weaving; the closure of Ramp C to eliminate an unsafe grade crossing; extension of the existing acceleration lane for the Route 20 northbound entrance ramp (Ramp N); relocation of the physical nose between the Route 20 northbound exit ramp (Ramp N) and Ramp K to increase the weaving distance to the split of Ramp B and Market Street eastbound (Ramp O); removal of trees and relocation of fence and utility poles near the northeast corner of the cemetery to improve horizontal curve stopping sight distance at this location; improvements to interchange signing along I-80 from Madison Avenue to River Drive and along Route 20 from 21st Avenue to Ramp K loop ramp.
