## Kapkowski Road, North Avenue and Trumbull Street, planning study

The county of Union recognizes that a Comprehensive Transportation Planning Study of the Kapkowski Road, North Avenue and Trumbull Street area is needed to examine and evaluate existing and proposed transportation improvements. It is critical that new and proposed developments in the area, as well as existing land uses, have specific transportation infrastructure improvements outlined prior to further construction. It is also important that an overall plan be put in place to ensure that the transportation system (which includes highway, transit and pedestrian elements) functions effectively.
