
Safety Performance Measures: How safe are NJTPA roads for all users?

Safety performance measures support the NJTPA's goal to improve overall system safety, reducing serious injuries and fatalities for all travelers on all modes. The measures reported here address fatalities and serious injuries on the roadway system. In addition, transit agencies track and report on several different safety performance measures, but due to the large number of transit measures, these are not reported here.


NJDOT data on all public roadways in the NJTPA region are used to analyze these measures. They are the same as the national performance measures, although annual numbers and rates are shown rather than 5-year rolling averages used for the national measures.
