# Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

- The purpose of HSIP is to achieve a significant reduction in traffic fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads
- HSIP requires a datadriven, strategic approach to improving highway safety on all public roads with a focus on performance. 23 CFR 924



#### NJDOT Road Safety Audits



- FHWA proven safety countermeasure
  - Formal safety performanceexamination of a road by anindependent team
  - Qualitatively estimates andreports on potential road safetyissues
  - Identifies opportunities forimprovement in safety for allroad users
- 50 RSAs completed since 2011



#### **Consultant Assistance Program**

Assist applicants to the Local Safety/ High Risk Rural Roads programs:

- Traffic counts
- Crash analysis
- Signal warrant analysis
- Lighting analysis
- Conceptual layouts






# Local Safety & High-Risk Rural Roads Programs

# **Typical Projects We Fund**

#### • Intersection improvements

- Traffic Signals and lane adjustments
- Pedestrian safety improvements
- Curb extensions (and associated drainage improvements)
- Lighting
- Road Diets
- Roundabouts
- Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons
- HRRR curves and corridors
  - High-friction surface treatments
  - Superelevation on curves
  - Centerline and edge line rumble stripes
  - Pavement markings and signs



#### Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act



- NJ should receive \$8 billion over 5 years based on formula
- Existing local programs received more money!
- Funded through 2026
