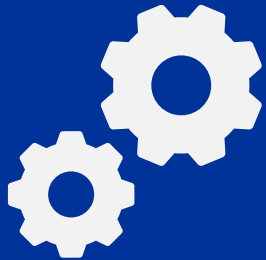

The SHSP is a five-year plan to drive down fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads.



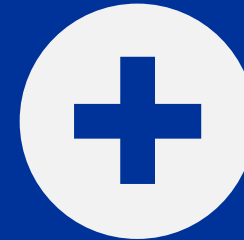
