Cean County received a \$1,594,636 grant for this project through the NJTPA's FY 2020 Local Safety Program (LSP). The grant includes funding for construction and construction inspection services. The project will improve safety and overall operations the intersection of Hooper Avenue (County Route 620) and Church Road/Kettle Creek Road in the Township of Toms River.

Project Details

Improvements will include signal upgrades and additional right-turn lanes.

About the Project Area

The intersection of Hooper Avenue and Church Road/Kettle Creek in Toms River Township is a 4-leg signalized intersection. A road safety audit (RSA) for the project area was conducted in December 2019 and many of the intersection recommendations will be built in this project.
