**H**udson County received a \$25,409,000 grant for this project through the NJTPA's FY 2022 Local Safety Program (LSP). The grant includes funding for preliminary engineering, final design, construction and construction inspection services. The project will improve safety and overall operations at 19 intersections throughout the City of Jersey City.

### Project Description

Improvements will include: signal upgrades, pedestrian signal upgrades, high-visibility crosswalks, curb extensions, and lead pedestrian intervals. New traffic signals will be installed at 15 intersections.

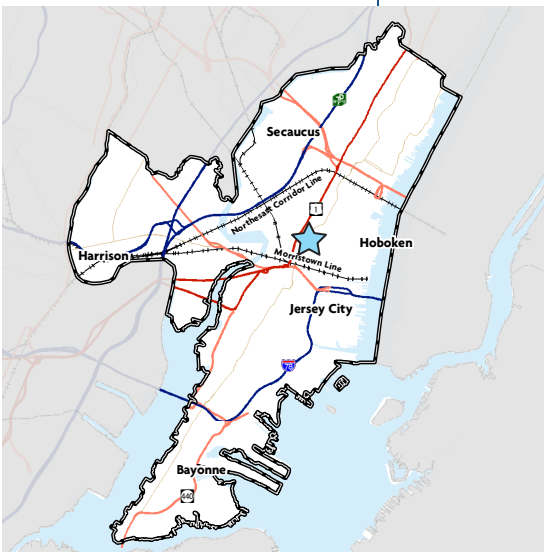
### About the Project Area

JFK (Kennedy) Boulevard is classified as an urban major arterial and critical north-south link within Jersey City traversing a high-density mix of commercial and residential land use with significant ongoing and planned

development. NJ State Route 139 is located at the southern project limit connecting JFK (Kennedy) Boulevard to the Pulaski Skyway and the Holland Tunnel. Secaucus Road (5th Street) is the border between Jersey City and the neighboring municipalities of Union City and North Bergen.

### The Local Safety Program

The LSP specializes in cost-effective solutions that can make an immediate impact on their target areas. The LSP is federally funded, utilizing Highway Safety Improvement Program funds. It was established by the NJTPA in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration and New Jersey Department of Transportation to advance safety initiatives on county and local roads.
