Passaic County received a \$5,879,000 grant for this project through the NJTPA's FY 2022 Local Safety Program (LSP). The grant includes funding for preliminary engineering, final design, construction and construction inspection services. The project will improve safety and overall operations at 15 intersections along Lakeview Avenue in the City of Clifton.

Project Description

Improvements will include: bicycle lanes, signal upgrades, high-visibility crosswalks and curb extensions. New traffic signals will be installed at three intersections.

About the Project Area

Lakeview Ave in Clifton is an important north-south connection between the City Paterson and the City of Passaic. The approximately one-mile corridor begins at the border of the City of Paterson and terminates at the intersection of Clifton

Avenue. Lakeview Avenue includes one travel lane in each direction and on-street parking. Land use is a generally mix of commercial and residential. A road safety audit (RSA) for the project area was conducted in October 2019 and many of the recommendations will be built in this project. The LSP specializes in cost-effective solutions that can make an immediate impact on their target areas. The LSP is federally funded, utilizing Highway Safety Improvement Program funds.
