Passaic County received a \$15,042,000 grant for this project through the NJTPA's FY 2022 Local Safety Program (LSP). The grant includes funding for preliminary engineering, final design, construction and construction inspection services. The project will improve safety and overall operations at 30 intersections along Valley Road in the Township of Wayne.

Project Description

Improvements will include: New sidewalks, bicycle lanes, traffic signal and pedestrian signal upgrades. New traffic signals will be installed at six intersections.

About the Project Area

Valley Road runs north-south through the Township of Wayne. The project area is approximately 3.22 miles, starting from French Hill Road and finishing at Hamburg Turnpike. The civic center of Wayne is located on the corridor which contains the

township municipal complex, the library and the high school. The project area contains diverse land uses including numerous retail centers and houses of worship as well as access to residential neighborhoods.

The Local Safety Program

The LSP specializes in cost-effective solutions that can make an immediate impact on their target areas. The LSP is federally funded, utilizing Highway Safety Improvement Program funds. It was established by the NJTPA in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration and New Jersey Department of Transportation to advance safety initiatives on county and local roads.
